Place:	Upper Austria, region Pyhrn-Eisenwurzen, Steyr, Kirchdorf/Krems.
Lodging:	First week Lodge Holzgraben, National Park Kalkalpen, second week homestay at rotarian Host-families.
Costs:	Journey to and from the nearest airport or train station; some pocket money will be required.
Program:	additional fee of 100 € required, to be paid after application is accepted  During the first week you will stay together with a ranger in the Camp Holzgraben in the National Park Kalkalpen. The lodge is located in a one hour walking distance from civilisation (Hengstpass Road) at a lonely, sunny clearing in the middle of the national park forest. The National Park Kalkalpen is the largest forestry conservation area of Austria. In the wilderness you experience how nature really is. The conscious perception of wilderness leads people to their origin and facilitates a new form of face to face encounter with nature. Observation of wild animals, fire technique, orientation in the wilderness is scheduled.  The Lodge is very comfortable. Food will be provided and finalized by the group. Cooking together at the firespot is one of the special highlights. For further detail see: www.kalkalpen.at  The second week is dedicated to give you an idea of (Upper-)Austrian culture in the broadest sense. Every day adresses one topic and is conducted by a Rotarian specialist in the particular field. For instance: architecture, music, working world − visiting companies, history, Austrian kitchen.  During this week you are guest at Rotarian families and there will be the opportunity to visit the weekly Rotary Meeting and also time for leisure activities.
Insurance:	Participant is obliged to pay 31 € on arrival for insurance against illness and accidents, including transport home if this should be necessary – or show a certificate of his/her local insurance company in English or German, which clearly states equivalence of insurance coverage. In case of any doubt, the organizers are <u>obliged</u> to demand payment of the 31 € insurance fee!
Arrival:	At Blue Danube Airport (Flughafen Linz Hörsching) or Linz Hauptbahnhof Train Station  If you arrive at Vienna International Airport (Flughafen Wien Schwechat) or at Munich Airport (Flughafen München) there are excellent train connections to Linz Main Station (Linz Hauptbahnhof)
